The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM by Commissioner Mullins. Commissioner Lipoti opened the meeting with recital of the Land Acknowledgement.

Commissioner Lipoti motioned that the prior meeting minutes from the June 17, 2021 meeting be approved. Commissioner Collar seconded the motion. (Motion carried, unanimously approved and passed.)

Financial Report

The vouchers for the month were reviewed and Sandra from King Water Company gave the bookkeeper report. A motion was made by Commissioner Lipoti that Maintenance vouchers (07) - 1 through (07) - 14 in the amount of \$7,480.52 plus EFT vouchers (07) 1 and (07) 2 in the amount of \$2,031.56 for a total of \$9,512.08 be approved. Commissioner Mullins seconded the motion. (Motion carried, unanimously approved and passed.)

Financial reports were reviewed. Cash in the Operating Fund at June, 2021 was \$114,160.99, the Short Term Asset Fund was \$5,927.00 and the Emergency fund was 101,103.93, of which \$99,000.00 is invested. The balance due on water bills was \$13,847.98, which includes past due accounts of \$6,844.45 (1 account for \$809.24 has been locked off, and one account for \$2,883.63 has had the meter removed with lien filed).

Manager/Operations Report

Sandra reviewed the Monthly Operations Report with the Commissioners.

Commissioner Mullins gave an update. Per Wilson Engineering they will go out to bid on project in January 2023. Commissioner Mullins will tell Whidbey Island Bank to hold off on funds for now. Commissioner Mullins asked to approve the engagement letter for the bond attorney for the project. All approved.

Action Items

- 1. Sandra Report on the % loss next time the meters are read. Concern since the number this month was 21% and the goal is 10%. Meters read today, so will find out the % loss next month.
- Sandra check with the reservoir cleaning people in Utah about a cost to fix the water level
 indicator on the Guemes Reservoir. Email sent. Sandra will follow up with a different company
 (Liquivision?) because there has been no response from the folks in Utah. Neither company has
 responded to Sandra so she will continue to follow up. Sandra found another company and sent
 another email.
- 3. Jill The geologist has prepared a letter to be sent to the Island County road department about the erosion due to the culvert. The Commissioners voted affirmatively to send the letter. Keep on the list for follow-up. Jill spoke with the road department when they were preparing to do the camera test on the culvert at Fidalgo. Replacement of the Fidalgo culvert is already in the budget and they are applying for the permits. However, they do not have additional funding for replacement of the culvert at Samish. Jill will write the letter.
- 4. Sandra The tablet is great, but the order in which the meters are listed is a problem. They need to be in walk order. They are currently in billing order. King will straighten out the order during the next few months and do one more meter reading to make sure everything is in working order. Then SHWD's new meter reader will take over, and perhaps another reader will also be hired.
- 5. Sandra/Brenda Send out a notice about the rate increase with the August billing.
- 6. **New Item** Sandra research when we are scheduled to transfer additional funding from the operating account to the short term asset account and then do the transfer.
- 7. New Item Sandra Order 1 additional booster pump to be installed this year using our short term asset fund. It may take 3 months to get the booster pump so order soon!
- 8. New Item Sandra Order 2 orange vests for the meter reader and maintenance person.
- 9. New Item Dave Dave's wife, Linda, has agreed to maintain our web site. She is going to meet with Julie O'Brien in September to learn how to do it.
- 10. New Item There was a report of a pipe burst due to high pressure on Hawaii Ave. Sandra reported that there were no reports on high water pressure during the weekend, but someone called to thank King Water for the great water pressure. They sent a technician to check and he found that a booster pump had not shut off promptly, but that water pressure was not excessive. Since only one pipe in one house burst, it is highly unlikely that the pipe break was due to King Water since if it was a system problem, other areas would have been affected.
- 11. New Item A citizen expressed concern that there was black slime coming from the water taps in her rental house. After much discussion, Sandra expressed that it could be due to iron bacterial growth. This can be treated with high amounts of chlorine or can be filtered out. The citizen agreed to look into treatment.
