The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Commissioner Mullins. Commissioner Lipoti opened the meeting with recital of the Land Acknowledgement.

Commissioner Lipoti motioned that the prior meeting minutes from the May 20, 2021 meeting be approved. Commissioner Mullins seconded the motion. (*Motion carried, unanimously approved and passed.*)

Commissioner Mullins preceded over the swearing in of Loretta Collar as Commissioner.

Audience Participation

Kurt Horton thanked the commissioners for the excellent notification of the flushing.

Financial Report

The vouchers for the month were reviewed and Sandra from King Water Company gave the bookkeeper report. A motion was made by Commissioner Lipoti that Maintenance vouchers (06) - 1 through (06) - 10 in the amount of \$11,057.61 plus EFT vouchers (06) 1 and (06) 2 in the amount of \$343.69 for a total of \$11,401.30 be approved. Commissioner Collar seconded the motion. (Motion carried, unanimously approved and passed.)

Financial reports were reviewed. Cash in the Operating Fund at May 31, 2021 was \$84,909.05, the Short Term Asset Fund was \$5,927.00 and the Emergency fund was Meeting minutes

101,055.88, of which \$99,000.00 is invested. The balance due on water bills was \$32,972.02, which includes past due accounts of \$7,155.43 (1 account for \$809.24 has been locked off, and one account for \$2,883.63 has had the meter removed with lien filed).

Manager/Operations Report

Sandra reviewed the Monthly Operations Report with the Commissioners.

Arsenic – raw water: It was noted that raw water samples were taken from each well and well #3 was very high in arsenic and #2 was below MCL. Though blending is helping keep the distribution levels below MCL we may not be able to maintain that level should DOH drop the MCL below 5 ppb.

USDA

Commissioner Mullins reported that there was nothing new to report on the USDA loan. He had applied for a \$300,000 line of credit from Whidbey Island Bank to cover expenses until USDA approval was made. Whidbey Island Bank won't approve any advances until USDA approval is made, thus the need for the credit line.

Commissioner Mullins also stated it is time to hire a bond attorney. Motion was made by Commissioner Mullins to hire a bond attorney and was seconded by Commissioner Collar. (*Motion carried, unanimously approved and passed.*)

Old Business/Pending

New Business

Bill Benshoof submitted his resignation from the manager position. Laurel Coombes was hired to take Bill's place. Laurel Coombes, Bill Benshoof and Commissioner Mullins will meet on June 24th to go over maintenance items that Ms. Coombes can take over from Bill.

Website – It was noted that the website hadn't been update for several months. King has sent over several items to be included on the website and noted that they had not seen them displayed on the website. Going forward the items being sent will be CC'd to the Commissioners.

Auditing Officer – It was noted that since Scott was resigning the auditing officer position was open. Commissioner Mullins motioned for Brenda Bosman to be appointed the Auditing Officer. Commissioner Lipoti seconded the motion. (*Motion carried*, unanimously approved and passed.)

Commissioner Mullins motioned to close the meeting at 7:54 PM.

Action Items with resolution in BOLD as discussed at July 15, 2021 meeting.

- 1. At the next flush, the techs brought a meter to measure the amount of water that is used during flushing. The estimates varied from 100,000 gallons to 200,000 gallons. The number will be reported at the July meeting. The meter showed a little over 100,000 gallons were used in the flushing. There will also be a report on the % loss as the number this month was 21% and the goal is 10%. The % loss is calculated when meters are read, and that will be done in August.
- 2. Monitoring Fidalgo slide our insurance company says that SHWD is not responsible any word from the County? This item is resolved our insurance company has dropped the claim.
- 3. Sandra check with the reservoir cleaning people in Utah about a cost to fix the water level indicator on the Guemes Reservoir. Email sent. Sandra will follow up with a different company (Liquivision?) because there has been no response from the folks in Utah. Neither company has responded to Sandra so she will continue to follow up. She is also asking the King Water technician whether they can rent a bucket truck and fix the problem themselves. What would it cost? Is it possible to do?
- 4. Jill reported on the geologist's findings regarding the undermining of the area near the well. The geologist will send a report, along with the pictures that he has taken. The issue is that a culvert is being undermined by water and is causing the erosion of the well area. The geologist says that it should be addressed promptly. It is possible the culvert belongs to the county. Sandra will send Jill names and numbers of county road department contacts and Jill will arrange to meet them to show them the area. The geologist has prepared a letter to be sent to the Island County road department about the erosion due to the culvert. The Commissioners voted affirmatively to send the letter.
- 5. Laurel Coombs will meet Bill Benshoof on June 24 to go over the meter reading and other job duties. The Commissioners voted to accept Laurel Coombs resignation, but to pay her for the time she spent with Bill Benshoof discussing job duties. A new ad for a meter reader will be prepared and hopefully a replacement will be hired quickly.
- 6. A lawnmowing contractor is still needed. Dave got one bid at \$500 per month during lawn growing season, but is looking at additional bids. Having trouble getting landscape contractors to return calls. Sandra will send contact info to Dave. A job description for a maintenance person will be drafted and advertised in the Whidbey Island News and Next Door, as well as the Scatchet Head Community Club newsletter.
- 7. Small tablet for meter reading was ordered and received. It is being set up to be used for the next meter reading. King Water will be requested to do the next meter reading since we don't have anyone at the moment. That way, they can also ensure that the tablet is working and that the info can be easily uploaded for billing.
- 8. Dave and Scott met with 2 of the engineering firms to show them the facilities. We are hopeful that we will receive several bids by the July 1 deadline. **Done.**
- Bill Benshoof has resigned as of June 30. Done.
- 10. Brenda Bosman will serve as the Auditing Officer, in addition to Dave. Done and the audit results were in our packet for the 7/15/21 meeting.
- 11. Commissioners voted to approve Dave engaging a bond attorney. Done.
