The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m by Commissioner Lipoti.
Commissioner Mach opened the meeting with recital of the Land Acknowledgement.

## Audience Participation

Homeowner on Driftwood explained that her shut off valve was hard to operate. She explained that during the last meter reading in May Nate Driscoll, from King Water, had told her they would replace it for her. She said she was still waiting for someone to come look at it. Sandra Bodamer said she was not aware of the situation, but would have someone look at it and take care of it.

Homeowner asked about the smell she was experiencing. She was asked if she had drained her hot water tank recently. She said she would try that first.

Silas Olsen, of NW Natural Water presented his company and the some things to expect with the transition from King Water Company.

## Financial Report

The vouchers for the month were reviewed. Commissioner Mullins motioned that vouchers (08)-1 through (08)- 8 in the amount of $\$ 26,431.54$, plus EFT voucher ( 08 )-1 in the amount of \$ for a total of $\$ 1,613.76$, plus Construction voucher ( 08 ) C-1 and ( 08 ) C-2 in the amount of $\$ 4585.50$, for a grand total of $\$ 32,630.80$ be approved. Commissioner Mach seconded the motion. (Motion carried, unanimously approved and passed.)

Financial reports were reviewed. Cash in the Operating Fund at July 31, 2023 was $\$ 128,074.63$, the Short-Term Asset Fund was $\$ 34,626.69$, the Investment fund was $\$ 279,302.42$, of which $\$ 274,000.00$ is invested, and the Construction Fund at $\$ 200.00$ for a total of $\$ 442,203.73$. The balance due on water bills was $\$ 8,028.08$ which includes past due accounts of $\$ 5,074.99$ (one account for $\$ 2,883.63$ has had the meter removed with lien filed, two accounts for $\$ 1563.43$ have meters locked).
