Resolution No. 2022-2

A RESOLUTION of the Scatchet Head Water District, Island County, Washington to adopt BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES regarding the System Upgrade Project:

Best Management Practices

Scatchet Head Water District agrees to Construction Best Management Practices (BMP) and will require all Contractors and Sub-contractors to comply with this Practice for temporary erosion, sedimentation, and dust controls during the construction of the System Upgrade Project.

Unanticipated Discovery Plan (UDP)

Scatchet Head Water District agrees that during the construction of our System Upgrade Project that if during any disturbing earth activities any cultural materials (ie structural remains, historic artifacts or prehistoric artifacts) are uncovered all work will cease and the Washington State Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation (DAHP) and the USDA Rural Development State Environmental Coordinator (SEC) shall be immediately notified. All materials will be evaluated on site by an archaeological monitor.


If during any disturbing activities on any area of the project uncover human remains, all work shall cease immediately in accordance with the Washington State Statue RCW27.44. The area around the discovery shall be secured and the Island County Coroner's office and the Rural Development SEC shall be notified immediately. If the remains appear to be prehistoric, the Rural Development (SEC) shall notify the State Archeologist at DAHP.

National Environmental Policy Act


